From the Pastor: Change, Challenge and Promise

Greetings in the name of our Teacher, Jesus Christ,

I hope this finds everyone in good health as once again we are struggling through an era of CoVid as the numbers for Iowa are on a quick increase. Many of us are frightened, many are despondent, and some are not worried; but there are changes taking place in all of the settings in which we live. My hope for you is that if you feel troubled, you will reach out to each other. As the Post-Pentecost year continues and we reflect on the work of the Spirit around us, may we remember we are a resurrection people. Take a good look around you and you will still see the Holy at work through the people.

Several months ago, I was approached by the Micronesian pastor of the United Church of Christ, Maquoketa, of Pohnpei about sharing access to our sanctuary. At the time we were still under construction with our Sanctuary remodel and updates.

After many months, and a mostly completed sanctuary remodel, we finally were able to move forward and meet together. Their vision is one of church sharing. They need a church home that is appropriate for their necessities in a small, poor, church with only 30 members. Our council met to look at setting up a trial period and crafting a Memorandum of Understanding between our two entities with thoughtful reflection on how they would be using our sacred spaces within the church building.

After Mary, Sue and I met their Senior Pastor Eliam and Associate Pastor Boaz, our church council endorsed the idea of sharing our sanctuary with this additional congregation on Sunday afternoons.



NIN is a special mission offering that supports ministries of justice and compassion throughout the United States. We will receive the NIN offering on Sunday, October 3, as part of our World Communion Sunday observation, but contributions can be made at any time.

This year, special consideration will be given to projects focusing on serving our immigrant neighbors and communities. 1/3 of the NIN funds support the Council for American Indian Ministry. 2/3 of this offering is used by the UCC's Justice and Witness Ministries.


